Maryland Department of Transportation's State Highway Administration (SHA) is pleased to announce its plans for "Scenic Byways Week," a campaign to be held July 28 - August 6, to promote Maryland's new Scenic Byway routes, signs, and map. **We invite you to join us for a kick-off event to be scheduled for July 31 with a rain date of August 1.**

SHA is planning to unveil 31 new scenic byways with a focus on heritage tourism, a new road sign design, and State map and book at this kickoff event, to be held at 10:00 AM at the B&O Train Museum in historic Ellicott City, Howard County. **The goal is to highlight Scenic Byways Week and draw attention to Maryland's environmental, historic and cultural destinations that can be visited by following the State's "roads less traveled."** These scenic routes are detailed on SHA's new statewide Scenic Byways Map as well as in an accompanying booklet, which is under development and will be ready for the kickoff event.
